





## The Masked Booby

The masked booby may not be as colorful as his blue-footed cousin, but he is larger. Masked boobies also eat flying fish, but they dive for squid as well. Although these ocean birds lay two eggs each breeding season, usually only one chick survives.

## The Northern Gannet

Northern gannets are the largest of all seabirds in the North Atlantic Ocean. They breed on rocky cliffs, and each bird greets its returning mate with an upstretched neck and bill tapping. Gannets can dive deeper than most birds, pursuing many fish.

## The Kittiwake

Kittiwakes are in the same family as seagulls and look much like them. They are named after the sound of their shrill call. Kittiwakes nest on some of the steepest cliffs along the North Atlantic and North Pacific Oceans.

## The Cape Petrel

Cape petrels, also called pintado petrels, have a unique speckled pattern to their plumage. These ocean birds feed on crustaceans and nest on islands near Antarctica. They will aggressively defend their nesting sites.

## The Atlantic Puffin

Atlantic puffins are small seabirds that live on the open ocean. They use their wings like flippers to swim underwater and hunt for fish. Puffins nest in rock crevices or shallow burrows along rocky shorelines or on nearby islands.

## The Shearwater

Shearwaters are medium-sized ocean birds with long wings. They live long and travel far. Some species migrate more than fourteen thousand kilometers between their nesting grounds in the southern hemisphere and their other, northern home.

## The Red-billed Tropicbird

Red-billed tropicbirds are some of the best fliers but worst swimmers among ocean birds. Their long central tail feathers can be as long as the rest of their body. Juvenile tropicbirds lack the tail streamer.
