

Cursive E - Practice Worksheet

Trace the grey letters, copy the black ones, then write E and e on your own.

A large cursive uppercase 'E' and lowercase 'e' are shown on a three-line grid. The uppercase 'E' starts at the baseline, loops up to the midline, back to the left, and then curves down to the baseline. The lowercase 'e' starts at the baseline, loops up to the midline, back to the left, and then curves down to the baseline.

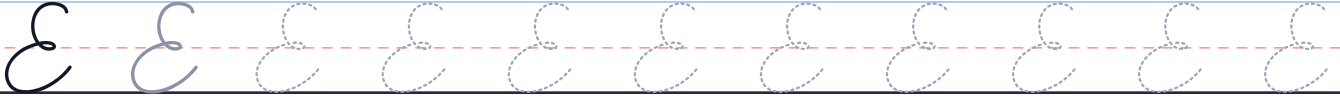
UPPERCASE E / LOWERCASE e

How to write the lowercase e

Swing up to the midline, loop back to the left and curve down to the baseline, then exit to the right.

Tip Keep the pencil on the paper for the whole letter. Dots and crosses come after the word is finished.

1. TRACE THE UPPERCASE E

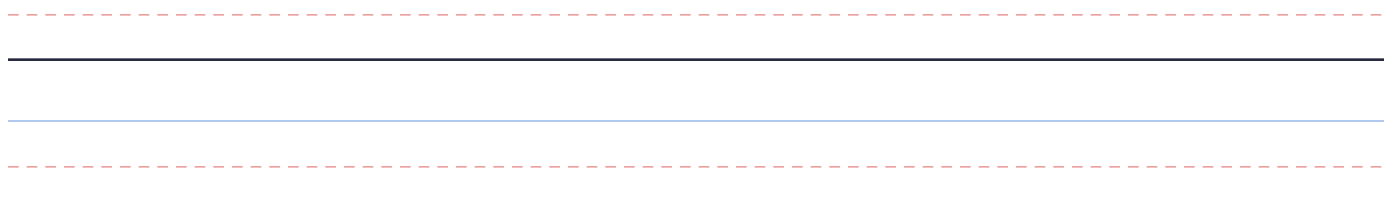
2. TRACE THE LOWERCASE E

A row of ten cursive lowercase 'e's on a three-line grid. The first is solid black, and the rest are dashed grey for tracing.A row of ten dashed grey cursive lowercase 'e's on a three-line grid for tracing.

3. TRACE AND COPY WORDS WITH E

The words 'egg' and 'eat' are written in cursive on a three-line grid. Each word is shown twice: first in solid black, and then in dashed grey for tracing.The words 'every' and 'easy' are written in cursive on a three-line grid. Each word is shown twice: first in solid black, and then in dashed grey for tracing.

4. WRITE E E AND YOUR WORDS ON YOUR OWN

Four sets of blank three-line grids (top blue, middle dashed red, bottom black) for independent practice of writing cursive 'E's and words.
