

Cursive M - Practice Worksheet

Trace the grey letters, copy the black ones, then write M and m on your own.

A large cursive uppercase 'M' and lowercase 'm' are shown on a three-line grid. The 'M' starts with an overcurve to the midline, then goes down and up twice for three humps. The 'm' starts with an overcurve to the midline, then goes down and up once for one hump.

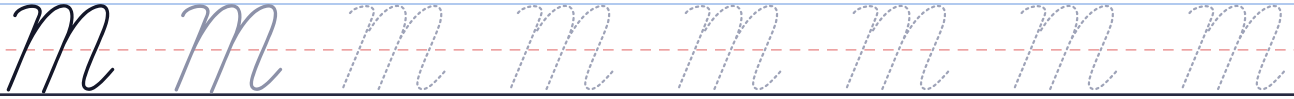
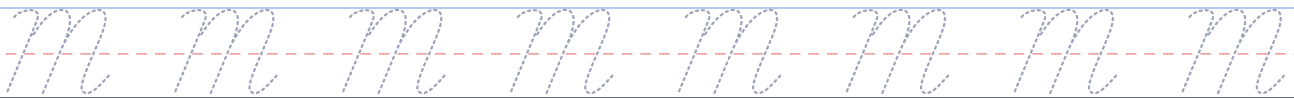
UPPERCASE M / LOWERCASE m

How to write the lowercase m

Overcurve to the midline and down, then up and over twice more for three equal humps, and exit.

Tip Keep the pencil on the paper for the whole letter. Dots and crosses come after the word is finished.

1. TRACE THE UPPERCASE M

A row of eight cursive uppercase 'M's on a three-line grid. The first two are solid black, and the remaining six are dashed grey for tracing.A second row of eight cursive uppercase 'M's on a three-line grid, all in dashed grey for tracing.

2. TRACE THE LOWERCASE M

A row of eight cursive lowercase 'm's on a three-line grid. The first two are solid black, and the remaining six are dashed grey for tracing.A second row of eight cursive lowercase 'm's on a three-line grid, all in dashed grey for tracing.

3. TRACE AND COPY WORDS WITH M

A row of four words on a three-line grid: 'mom', 'mom', 'map', and 'map'. The first two are solid black, and the last two are dashed grey for tracing.A second row of four words on a three-line grid: 'milk', 'milk', 'moon', and 'moon'. The first two are solid black, and the last two are dashed grey for tracing.
