

Cursive R - Practice Worksheet

Trace the grey letters, copy the black ones, then write R and r on your own.

A large cursive uppercase 'R' and a smaller lowercase 'r' are shown on a set of three horizontal lines (top, middle dashed, and bottom). The 'R' starts at the middle line, goes up to the top line, then down to the bottom line, and back up to the middle line. The 'r' starts at the bottom line, goes up to the middle line, and then back down to the bottom line.

UPPERCASE R / LOWERCASE r

How to write the lowercase r

Swing up to the midline, make a tiny flat shoulder, come straight down to the baseline and exit.

Tip Keep the pencil on the paper for the whole letter. Dots and crosses come after the word is finished.

1. TRACE THE UPPERCASE R

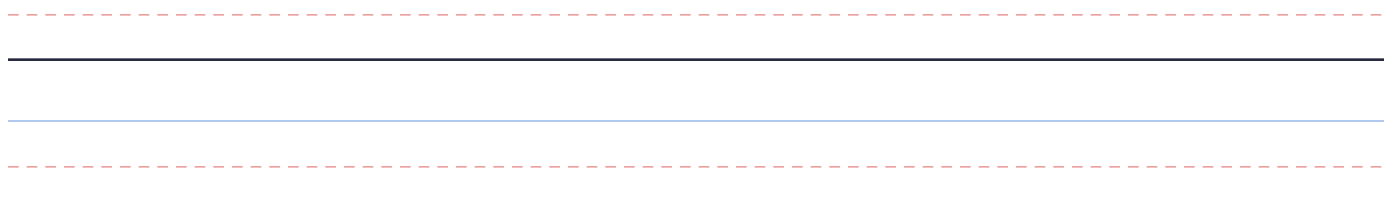
2. TRACE THE LOWERCASE R

A row of cursive lowercase 'r's on handwriting lines. The first is solid black, and the rest are dashed grey for tracing.A row of cursive lowercase 'r's on handwriting lines. All are dashed grey for tracing.

3. TRACE AND COPY WORDS WITH R

The words 'rat' and 'run' are written in cursive on handwriting lines. The first instance of each word is solid black, and the second is dashed grey for tracing.The words 'rain' and 'river' are written in cursive on handwriting lines. The first instance of each word is solid black, and the second is dashed grey for tracing.

4. WRITE R R AND YOUR WORDS ON YOUR OWN

Four sets of blank handwriting lines (top, middle dashed, and bottom) for independent practice of writing cursive 'R's and words.
