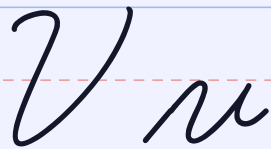


Cursive V - Practice Worksheet

Trace the grey letters, copy the black ones, then write V and v on your own.

A large cursive uppercase 'V' and a smaller cursive lowercase 'v' are shown on a three-line grid. The 'V' starts with an overcurve from the baseline to the midline, curves down to the baseline, swings up to the midline, and finishes with a bridge stroke. The 'v' follows a similar pattern but stays between the baseline and the midline.

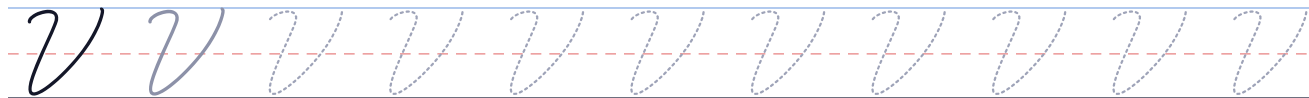
UPPERCASE V / LOWERCASE v

How to write the lowercase v

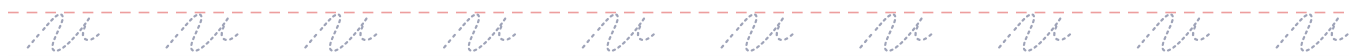
Overcurve to the midline, curve down to the baseline, swing up to the midline and finish with a bridge stroke.

Tip Keep the pencil on the paper for the whole letter. Dots and crosses come after the word is finished.

1. TRACE THE UPPERCASE V

A row of cursive uppercase 'V's on a three-line grid. The first 'V' is solid black, and the following ten are dashed grey for tracing.A second row of eleven dashed grey cursive uppercase 'V's on a three-line grid for tracing practice.

2. TRACE THE LOWERCASE v

A row of cursive lowercase 'v's on a three-line grid. The first 'v' is solid black, and the following ten are dashed grey for tracing.A second row of eleven dashed grey cursive lowercase 'v's on a three-line grid for tracing practice.

3. TRACE AND COPY WORDS WITH V

The words 'van' and 'vet' written in cursive on a three-line grid. Each word is shown twice: first in solid black and then in dashed grey for tracing.The words 'vine' and 'very' written in cursive on a three-line grid. Each word is shown twice: first in solid black and then in dashed grey for tracing.

4. WRITE V V AND YOUR WORDS ON YOUR OWN

Four sets of blank three-line grids (top blue, middle dashed red, bottom blue) for independent practice of writing cursive 'V's and words.
